Eligibility Criteria:

- Full or 50% time student in four/two-year college, or secondary school.
- A Luo by birth, marriage, or adoption unless otherwise decided by the committee.
- Secondary school applicants pursuing high school in Kenya with exemplary performance (top 5% of their class), and in financial need.
- Financial need based on income or other resources owned by the family such as land, livestock, rental houses, etc
- Willingness to volunteer his/her time to community activities such as assisting elderly people in villages, helping children with low aptitude reading during school holidays, and other activities deemed necessary by the association.
- The amount of money to be awarded will be determined by the scholarship committee.

Requirements:

1. Application letter stating the financial need, family background, and what the applicant plan to do to the community on completion of their education.
2. Three letters of recommendations from headmaster or academic advisor, a teacher/professor who is conversant with the students' academic performance, and chief/assistant chief or church priest from the applicant's sub-location.
3. Original report forms for three terms, and a copy of KCPE certificate for secondary school applicants. For college applicants (in Kenya – transcripts for two semesters or one semester and a copy of KCSE certificate) while the applicants in the US must provide transcripts with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or a B grade based on Kenya educational system.
4. Applications done annually, the committee will announce deadlines, and all the applications received by the deadline will be considered equally.

Selection Criteria: The student must have the potential to excel academically, show exceptionally leadership potential, and can make impact in the community through public service and helping others.

Progress Evaluation: Original transcript mailed to Sango every semester or report form every term. If Sango association felt performance is not satisfactory then the financial assistance will be terminated at the end of the year. Students performing up to the standards expected by the association can be considered for future assistance, and supplemental funding to the scholarship will be highly appreciated. The money can be used for tuition, fees, accommodation, and books.
